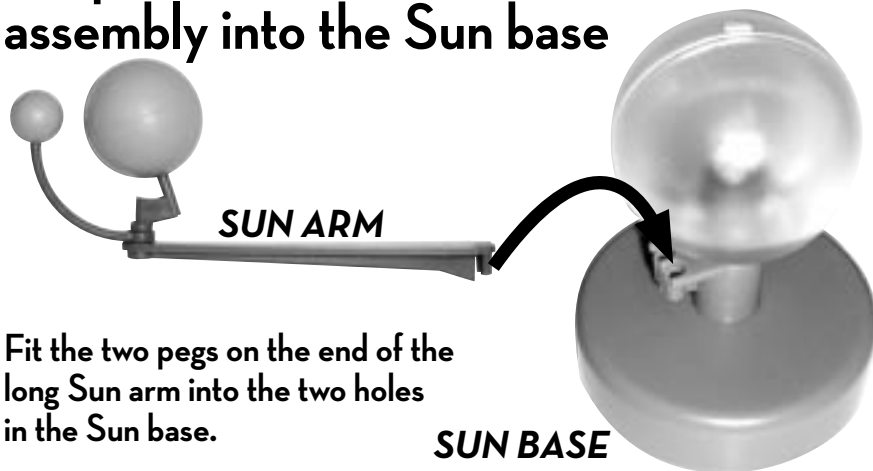


# SUN, EARTH, and MOON

## Assembly Instructions

Requires 2 AA batteries and a screwdriver (not included).

### Snap the Earth and Moon assembly into the Sun base

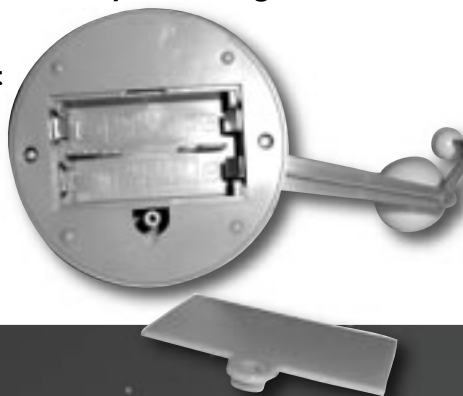


Fit the two pegs on the end of the long Sun arm into the two holes in the Sun base.

### Install the batteries

1. Unscrew the battery compartment door on the bottom of the base.
2. Insert two AA batteries into the battery compartment. Make sure the batteries are inserted the correct way, according to the diagram inside the battery case.
3. Screw the battery compartment door back onto the battery compartment.
4. Turn the ON/OFF switch to ON and the Sun lights up.



### How to Change the Bulb in the Sun

Change the bulb only with parent supervision.

1. Unscrew the two screws at the bottom of the Sun.
2. Pull the two halves of the Sun apart.
3. Replace the bulb with a 2.4 volt, 0.5 amp bulb.
4. Snap the two halves of the Sun back together.
5. Screw the two screws into the holes at the bottom of the Sun.



### Battery Cautions

- To ensure proper safety and operation, the battery replacement must always be done by an adult.
- Never let a child use this product unless the battery door is secure.
- Keep all batteries away from small children, and immediately dispose of any batteries safely.
- Batteries are small objects and could be ingested.
- Non-rechargeable batteries are not to be recharged.
- Rechargeable batteries are to be removed from toy before being charged.
- Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.
- Different types of batteries or new and used batteries are not to be mixed.
- Only batteries of the same or equivalent types as recommended are to be used.
- Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc), or rechargeable (nickel-cadmium) batteries.
- Batteries are to be inserted with the correct polarity.
- Exhausted batteries are to be removed from the toy.
- The supply terminals are not to be short-circuited.
